Oklahoma Housing

• Oklahoma led the nation for home value appreciation in the second quarter of 2008 compared to the second quarter of 2007. Oklahoma home values rose 4.9 percent, while nationally home values fell 1.7 percent.

New Store Openings / Hirings

- Two hotels are planned for Edmond, east of Broadway and south of Bob Howard Used Cars. The first one will be an extended-stay hotel with 92 rooms and the second should have around 100 rooms. Completion for the first hotel is expected within 13 months. Construction on the second hotel will start about eight months after the first one opens.
- Texas-based American First Insurance announced they have opened a regional office in OKC at Quail Springs Parkway.
- Construction on a new headquarters for the Central Oklahoma Home Builders Association has begun just east of Broadway Extension on Britton Road. Completion is expected in the fall of 2009.

- Oklahoma City television network KSBI-TV has started construction on a new broadcast facility. The new location on North Morgan Road will replace the current facility at SE 82nd Street.
- Sean Cummings' Irish Restaurant & Pub opened at 9610 N May in OKC.
- Tinker Federal Credit Union has opened a branch at 1401 S Post Road in Midwest City.
- A two-story building currently being constructed in Edmond on Fifth Street, between S Boulevard and S Littler Avenue, will house Parkway Cleaners, Myers Insurance, and a Pita Pit restaurant. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of November.
- RCB Bank of Nichols Hills has opened a new location at 7400 N Western.
- Construction has begun on the AAA operations center at 3100 Quail Springs Parkway. When completed in September 2009, the center will bring 825 jobs to OKC.
- A 102-room Country Inn & Suites has opened at 2401 S Meridian Ave.
- Tulsa-based Media Specialists, an audio and video installation company, is expanding into OKC with a new office in the Collonade at 9632 N May Ave.

Unemployment

- In the OKC metro, the unemployment rate for July 2008 decreased to 4.0% from June's rate of 4.2%. In July 2007, the metro's unemployment rate was higher at 4.3%.
- Statewide, the unemployment rate for July 2008 decreased to 4.0% from June's rate of 4.2%. In July 2007, the state's unemployment rate was higher at 4.4%.
- Nationally, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for July 2008 increased to 5.7% from June's rate of 5.5%. The national unemployment rate for July 2007 was lower at 4.7%. *Source: U.S. Dept of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics*

Retail Trade (updated statistics have not been released since the last Market Snapshot)

- Total retail trade in the OKC MSA for the first two months of 2008 (Jan. Feb.) was up 8.3% over the same period in 2007.
- Four sectors were down for YTD 2008 compared to YTD 2007: Used Merchandise (-8.0%), General Merchandise (-0.2%), Apparel (-5.6%), and Miscellaneous Non-Durable Goods (-5.7%).
- Two categories showed gains greater than 10% compared to YTD 2007: Electronics/Music Stores (+10.9%), and Estimated Gasoline (+53.4%).
- All other categories showed single-digit gains: Lumber/Hardware (+7.3%), Auto Accessories & Repair (+1.8%), Furniture (+1.7%), Miscellaneous Durable Goods (+7.6%), Food (+0.6%), Eating/Drinking (+8.0%), Drugs (+8.5%), and Liquor (+0.5%).
